





#### **Town Hall with OI Board of Directors**

- Main topic was Issue 2 (Proposed \$15 Dues Increase)
  - Audience questions
    - Has OI considered establishing endowment to cover OI costs instead of raising dues?
      - OI Exec Director Cheryl Brenn's Response:
        - OI looking at all options for non-dues revenue
    - Has OI considered splitting dues increase into increments instead of all at once?
      - OI Pres-Elect Bob McFadyen's Response:
        - OI has lost members for past 30 years
        - Incremental increase is not practical
        - \$15 increase intended to offset projected deficit & invest in future
    - Can OI consider billing dues annually instead of quarterly?
      - OI Audit & Finance Chair Sandi Schmidt's Response:
        - OI will lose money if OI bills annually at start of Optimist Year and if clubs grow throughout year

#### **Town Hall with OI Board of Directors**

- Main topic was Issue 2 (Proposed \$15 Dues Increase)
  - Audience questions cont.
    - Can OI Foundation gift 3-7% to OI?
      - OI Exec Director Cheryl Brenn's Response:
        - OI Foundation helps offset some OI administrative costs
        - It is up to OIF to decide how to spend their funds
      - OI Foundation Pres Marc Katz' Response:
        - OI Foundation is giving ~\$250,000 to OI for 2022-2023 Optimist Year
  - OI Pres Patsy Garner's points
    - OI Members do not pay OI or district dues → Clubs do
    - Clubs do not need to pass on dues increase to members
    - Clubs can fundraise to offset dues increase
    - OI is looking at all membership categories to determine equitable dues structure

- Other topics
  - Audience questions
    - Issue 8: Why raise minimum number of members required to charter new club from 15 to 20?
      - OI Pres Patsy Garner's Response:
        - New clubs lose ~20% of members in first 3-6 months so starting with 20 members improves new club's chances of success
    - Who does OI notify when clubs are in arrears?
      - OI Pres Patsy Garner's Response:
        - Clubs that reach 60 days in arrears: Ol will notify Club Pres, Sec, Treas, & applicable Lt Gov
        - Clubs that reach 90 days in arrears: In addition to notifying Club Pres, Sec, Treas, & applicable Lt Gov, OI will notify Club Pres-Elect, Sec-Designate, Treas-Designate, & applicable Lt Gov-Elect


- Many of Ol's practices are outdated
