



## Guidelines for the CO/WY D/HH District contest:

The rules are the same for both Oratorical and CCDHH contest with a few exceptions:  
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- 1) The student must NOT have graduated from high school yet.
- 2) We have two \$2500 scholarships, one for a student presenting in sign language and one for an oral presentation.
- 3) If a student has a cochlear implant, then the requirement for an audiogram is replaced by an audiologist's Programming Report.
- 4) There are no Zone contests; students go from the club to the District.
- 5) If a local club runs a contest with three or more students, only the top three can be entered in the District contest.
- 6) There is no entry fee for the District contest, however clubs are required to provide their students with interpreters.
- 7) Since students go directly from the club to the District, we recommend that the club encourage the student to present at one or more meetings. Thus, they can practice their presentation and receive moral support and constructive pointers to better prepare for competition.
- 8) We strive to ensure equity of presentation recording, with the best equipment and qualified people to assist the student. If a student or school can't make an MP4 compatible recording of the student's presentation, Zoom Appointments to record are available.
